Manifest MedEx (MX) helps patients and providers get the information they need to make informed health care decisions. MX aims to be the smart grid for health information, delivering data-driven insight to individuals, providers and health plans when and where they need it so they can improve care, lower costs and enhance health. MX combines more than 11 million claims and 5 million clinical records from five health plans and approximately 150 participating providers, representing 22 percent of the hospital beds statewide (excluding Kaiser). Our data creates a strong foundation for seamless, personalized and effective care for Californians.

MX Services



Real time encounter alerts: Care management teams can contact patients the day of a hospital discharge to schedule follow-up appointments. This helps improve care coordination and avoid readmissions.



Query services to access longitudinal patient record: Physicians and emergency departments can provide the most appropriate care during clinical visits informed by patients' medical history, allergies and clinical problems.



Analytics and Business Intelligence: Population health managers receive data needed to understand and manage the cost and quality of care for attributed patients including identifying and filling gaps in care, reducing readmissions, managing medications and decreasing emergency department use.



Support for Care Management: Care managers have data and tools to identify and manage care for high complexity patients and target care management resources.

Safeguarding Data

MX abides by stringent technical, administrative and physical safeguards to protect and maintain the privacy and security of personal health information. MX respects patients' right to privacy and follows all applicable state and federal privacy laws.

- Data is encrypted in transit and at rest
- Patients can opt out of having their information shared through MX
- Authorized users undergo training prior to accessing MX systems
- Data cannot be used for health plan contracting
